The department and university centre boards will ensure the teaching hours included in the curricula for each discipline are met.

## **EXAM PERIODS AND SIGNING OF MINUTES**

The centres will adapt the exam dates for each subject to the indicated periods.

Distribution of evaluation periods and deadline for signing minutes		
<b>1st semester subjects</b> REGULAR EXAM PERIOD	15 - 19 December 2025 and 8 - 17 January 2026	27 January 2026
2nd semester & annual subjects REGULAR EXAM PERIOD	11 - 30 May 2026	9 June 2026
<b>1st &amp; 2nd semester &amp; annual subjects</b> Extraordinary Exam Period	15 Jun to 2 july 2026	10 July 2026

If in the exams planning had less than 48 hours between subjects in the same course, the beginning of the evaluation period could be anticipated in order to respect this deadline.

In September 2026, university centres may enable an additional call for defense of 'Final Projects' corresponding to the 2025-2026, academic year. In these cases, grades delivery will be, at most, until September 25, 2026.

In the case of external practices enrolled in the 2025-2026, academic year, which will be carried out in non-teaching period during the months of July and August 2026, grades delivery will be, at most, until September 25, 2026.

Within the general framework set out in this timetable, and in the exercise of their functions, the centres may adapt the periods of classes and exam to the specific needs of each degree, provided that grades delivery deadlines are respected and compliance with class schedules is guaranteed.

During non-teaching days, lectures o exhibitions of doctoral theses, ordinary meetings of governing bodies or elections, may not be held in the university community.

July 13 – 24, 2026, shall be considered teaching days for the sole purposes of exhibitions of doctoral theses, undertaking extraordinary exam reviews or other necessary academic activities. These activities will take place in the morning or remotely.

If the days declared a local, regional or national holiday for 2026 are different from those detailed in this calendar, then the corresponding days will be automatically modified from teaching to non-teaching days (and vice versa).
